

A TOOL IN THE SERVICE OF STUDENTS

- **full** and **updated** information on higher education, fields of study, degrees, institutions, and research, among other topics

- simple search for training by domain / keyword / level or by school among more than 650 programs offered: **Public preparatory classes FLE + Art / Design, L (license), M (Master), Post-M or D (PhD)**, in public or private institutions all members of the Forum Campus France

- creation of a **single** online application file for several applications

- **distance admission** procedure without competition and without physical passage before a jury of equivalence

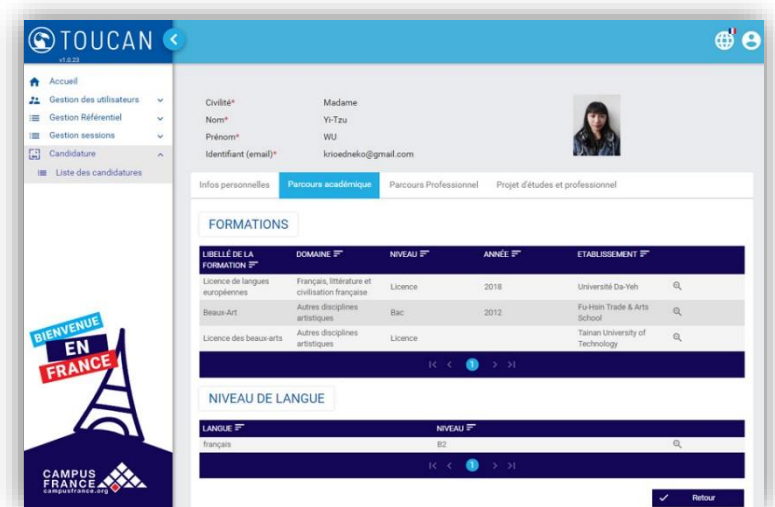

- for the students concerned: 1 **simplified and accelerated** study procedure in France reserved for students enrolled via CampusArt in the institutions.





PREREQUISITES

CAMPUSART PREREQUISITES

- Depending on the training, justify a baccalaureate level, 1, 2 or 3 years of higher education in art, design or architecture;
- Depending on the training, present your work online (personal website, blog, portfolio ...);
- Justify a medium level in French (except to enter certain formations such as preparatory classes);

APPLICATION FEES

The application is free.

CampusArt management fees paid by the student to the Campus France Paris Agency, **only if the student decides to accept the offer of registration made by the institution**

STUDY IN FRANCE

TESTS AND DEGREES IN FRENCH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE

Five countries host more than half of the world's international students: the United States, the United Kingdom, Australia, France and Germany. France hosts 343,400 international students, putting it in fourth place after the United States, the United Kingdom, Australia but before Germany. International students account for 12% of enrollments in French Higher Education.

FRENCH AN INTERNATIONAL LANGUAGE

Spoken by 274 million people around the world, French is an official language of 32 states on 5 continents. With English and German, it is one of the working languages of the European Union, the third-most-common business language, and the second-most-common language of news. With 125 million learners of French and 900,000 teachers, it is, after English, the most widely taught language on the planet. Since 2001, the Council of Europe's CEFR has set reference levels for foreign-language proficiency. The CEFR has become Europe's standard for language learning, with 6 levels of proficiency for purposes of admission to French postsecondary institutions.

TCF (Test de connaissance du français - Test of knowledge of French)

The TCF, administered by the French Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Higher Education, Research and Innovation, is a standardized test of general French designed by CIEP (Centre international d'études pédagogiques, international center for pedagogical studies), a certifying organization that is a member of ALTE (the Association of Language Testers in Europe). The TCF satisfies the quality requirements of ISO 9001, version 2008, in all of its processes.

The TCF test of comprehension and the computer-based test of written expression may be taken on computer in some countries.

Test results are valid for 2 years. Candidates wishing to repeat the TCF or TCF-DAP must wait 30 days from the date of their prior sitting. www.ciep.fr/en/tcf-dap

> Description of the TCF and TCF-DAP:

> Registration fees and locations: Candidates can take the TCF in 712 centers approved by CIEP. Centers are located in 126 countries, including France. To register, candidates should contact an approved center for information on testing dates and for the costs of the required and elective components of the test.

TCF AND DIPLOMAS IN FRENCH LANGUAGE REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION TO POSTSECONDARY PROGRAMS

The levels of academic achievement required to obtain an admission visa for study in France were set forth in an interministerial circular (from the ministries of the Interior, Foreign Affairs, and Higher Education and Research) dated January 21, 2009. The criteria included the candidate's educational level, the quality of the candidate's prior academic program, and the institutional framework of the proposed program of study in France. Criterion 4 deals with the importance of 'language proficiency with assessment of applicants' proficiency in French, including applicants who show exceptional academic potential.'

Several tests of French proficiency and diplomas in French language are accepted for purposes of admission into a French institution of Higher Education

> To enroll in the first year of a program in a university (Licence 1) or school of architecture, international students (from outside the European Union) must follow the so-called preliminary admission procedure, known as DAP. Applicants must demonstrate their language proficiency normally by taking the TCF-DAP or entering a DELF B2 diploma (or higher). The TEF may be accepted in lieu of the TCF-DAP if the applicant scored at least 14/20 on the written portion of the TEF. Some universities accept the DUEF (Diplôme universitaire d'études françaises) for admission into the first year of university study (Licence 1).

> For enrollments in the third year of university study (Licence 2 or 3), in a Master's program, (Master 1 and 2), in a Doctoral program, or in one of France's Grandes Écoles, no uniform requirement applies.

Each institution is free to set its own criteria for French proficiency. Prospective students should inquire about the language requirements of the institutions of interest to them.

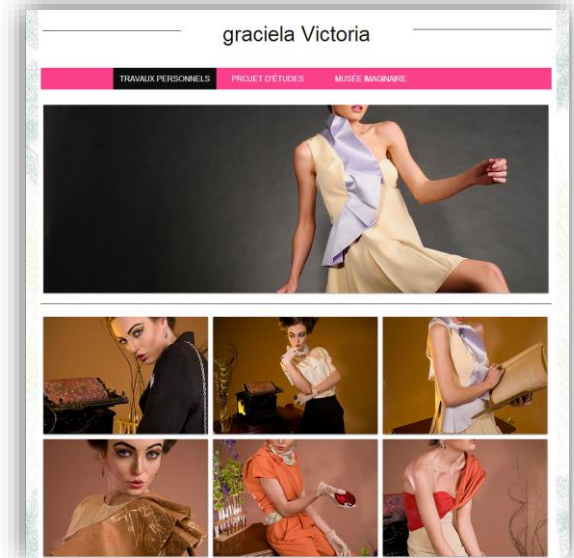
- **mandatory** for all applications to programs who ask for, in art or architecture

- **online**, active url in the candidate's file, or a **pdf** on CampusArt account: presentation of works on a blog or free portfolio, on a website built by you or link to a pdf including all the items requested. Free blogging solutions: www.behance.net, www.ultra-book.com/portfolios, <http://cargocollective.com>, ...
Composed of **3 chapters**:

- personal artistic works (\pm 20 works): drawings, sketches, models, photographs, 2D / 3D animation, sculptures, ...
briefly describe the materials and intentions

- imaginary museum (\pm 10 works)

- possible additional documents (recent language test, diplomas or transcript of the current year ...)



REGISTRATION FEES

Public universities

- Licence: 170 euros for students from the European Economic Area and Switzerland // 2,770 euros for international students outside the European Economic Area.
- Master: 243 euros for students from the European Economic Area and Switzerland, 3,770 euros for international students outside the European Economic Area.
- Doctorate: 380 euros

Exemptions are possible for students subject to differentiated fees. They can be offered on CampusArt by:

- host establishments according to their attractiveness strategy defined upstream. The exemptions offered by these establishments can be total or partial;
- diplomatic posts according to their budgetary envelope and their policy vis-à-vis excellent candidates or their university cooperation strategy.

Public Higher Schools of Art and Design and National Higher Schools of Public Architecture

- Diplôme National d'Art (DNA) - License degree: from 350 euros for students in public art schools
- Diplôme d'Etudes En Architecture (DEEA) - License degree: from 370 euros for students in public architecture schools
- Diplôme National Supérieur d'Expression Plastique (DNSEP) - Master degree: from 400 euros for students in public art schools
- Diplôme d'Etat d'Architecture (DEA) - Master degree: from 512 euros for students in public architecture schools

To these amounts may be added additional costs for specific services.

Public schools of art and architecture are not subject to differentiated fees.

Private schools

The cost of enrollment in private establishments is significantly higher (generally 3,000 to 20,000 euros per year).



- CampusArt makes electronic applications available online (by sending access codes to CampusArt member institutions)
- Institutions contact applicants: telephone or skype interviews, videoconferences, ...
- Schools nominations to candidates on their CampusArt account

APRIL THROUGH JUNE

- Candidates accept or decline offers of admission
- Formal offers of admission are prepared and mailed by CampusArt

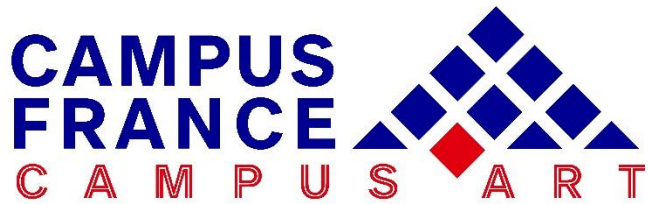
